



Interoperability is key

Having access to the right information at the right time is important in healthcare.

Leadership standardization by Ministry of Health, Welfare and Sport

Collaboration. Where governance, National vision & strategy, the (broad) healthcare-field, agreements (IZA), law (WEGIZ) and European rules (EHDS) meet.

How to make standardization happen?

Healthcare providers in 50.000 different organizations must record and digitally exchange healthcare information in an unambiguous manner.

Interoperability: change, chance of a challenge?

Each healthcare organization is different in how they organize processes, in IT-systems and on recording patient's health information.




Systematized Nomenclature Of Medicine

SNOMED is a standardized, multilingual vocabulary of clinical terminology that is used by healthcare providers for the electronic exchange of health information.








